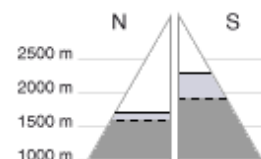

Snowpack distribution

Snowpack levels for northern and southern orientation.

- **White shape:** with continuous snowpack
- **Continuous line:** continuous snowpack level
- **Light grey shape:** with discontinuous snowpack
- **Dashed line:** discontinuous snowpack level
- **Dark grey shape:** without snowpack

Loose snow avalanche

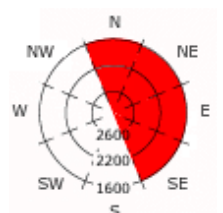


Loose snow avalanche

Avalanche danger by aspect and height

In red color orientation and heights prone to avalanches.

In red color day time prone to wet snow avalanches
